Schoenbergs New Citizens

Arnold Schoenberg, music professor at the University of California at Los Angeles, and his wife, Gertrud, were granted citizenship today in a brief proceeding before Federal Judge Ben Harrison.

They beamed as they left the courtroom after the ceremony in which, with a number of others, they took the oath of citizenship.

"I'm happy indeed to become a citizen of this great country," Schoenberg said.

Schoenberg entered this country at Calexico Nov. 14, 1935. He took out his first papers with his wife in February, 1936.

According to his citizenship application, he and his wife are of Czech origin—but were born in Vienna.
